

ST. MARTHA SUMMER CAMP

“Must Know Info”

Daily/General

- *Your child must be signed in and out daily**
- *We are open 7 am to 6 pm (no required drop off time)**
- A daily lunch from home is required except for Mondays (see below) and special field trips indicated on the calendar. Please see the handbook for state guidelines on lunch requirements.**
- Snack is provided daily at 9am and 3pm. (This is not a meal)**
- Toys are permitted in the school-age program only, but please keep it to a minimum. Space is limited and it’s a big responsibility. (No Electronics)**
- Summer reading is part of summer camp. If your child has required summer reading, he/she may bring in their book.**
- With so many children, it is important to put your child’s name on their belongings.**

Swim/Water Play Days (weather permitting)

- Every child is required to send in a bottle of Coppertone Spray Sunscreen SPF 50. (if sending in a face stick, please send it in a bag with their name)**
- Try to be here by 9:30am on swim days.**
- Dress your child in their swimsuit and bring a change of clothes and towel.**
- Send a life jacket if you wish. (we do not have them)**
- Send in \$2.50 per child for pizza lunch. (Optional)**
- Pre School Children are required to wear water shoes or other shoes that can get wet (NO FLIP FLOPS). They are in the grass and can get stung or step on a foreign object.**
- School-age children may wear flip flops on pool days only.**

Misc. Information

- Summer Camp will start May 28th and end August 9th. After School Care will begin tentatively August 15th, our first day of school. We will not be open on Mon, Tue, or Wed. of that week. Our teachers and maintenance will need the space available to prepare for a new school year.**

Emergency Procedures

- If we ever have an emergency that prohibits us from using the school building, the teachers will take the children to the gymnasium. All parents would be contacted to pick up their children.
- If the disaster prohibits us from being on the school grounds, the teachers will move the children to the Elk's ledge located across the street from St. Martha.

Pre School and Kindergarten Ready

- Your child will need a complete change of clothes to be kept at the center for any accidents or spills that may occur.
- For rest period your child will need a small sleep blanket and sheet OR sleep mat with a pillow and blanket attached.
- It is required that your child wear tennis shoes or closed toed shoes that has a back. (no flip flops or heels)
- Toys from home are not permitted.
